

RUPERT BOYD, CLASSICAL GUITARIST

New York-based Australian classical guitarist **Rupert Boyd** has been described by *The Washington Post* as "truly evocative", by *Gramophone* as "a very fine musician", and by *Classical Guitar Magazine* as "a player who deserves to be heard". He has performed across four continents, from New York's Carnegie Hall, to festivals in Europe, China, India, Nepal, the Philippines, New Zealand and Australia.

Active as both a soloist and chamber musician, Rupert Boyd regularly performs throughout the world as part of the Australian Guitar Duo with guitarist Jacob Cordover, and in *Boyd Meets Girl*, with cellist Laura Metcalf.

Rupert Boyd has five commercially released albums. His most recent solo CD, *The Guitar (Sono Luminus)*, was called "a must-have album of 2019" by *This Is Classical Guitar*, and received the following praise in *The Weekend Australian*: "Instantly one's ears are pricked up by Boyd's interpretive directness and a sparkling technique."
